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SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Make sure to read the "Safety precautions" in this guide before using this product.

WARNING

- Failure to follow the installation instructions included with the display could result in injury and product damage which may not be covered by the warranty.
- · Do not open or disassemble the display.
- You risk electrical shock from the high voltage inside the casing. Opening the casing also voids the warranty.
- Do not stand (or allow children to stand) on a chair to touch the surface of the display.

Connecting via HDMI input port on the front




Connecting via HDMI using the HDMI input port on the side



Connect one end of the HDMI cable to the HDMI input port of the monitor and other end to the HDMI output port of the computer. The computer screen will be displayed on the monitor.

- When performing touch operations of the computer on the monitor, connect between the touch port of the monitor and the USB port of the computer using the USB cable.
- When using the touch port on the front of the monitor, use the HDMI input port on the front. When using the touch port on the side of the monitor, use the HDMI input port at the side.

Connecting with VGA cable and audio cable




Connecting with HDMI cable
